*Prologue

In the Bible, there is a story of faith and eternal promises, from Genesis to the book of Revelation. This story begins in Eden when the Lord created Adam and gave him three incorruptible, eternal, and holy promises: the eternally multiplied descendants, the eternal government, and the Earth. Adam had the requirements to receive and enjoy these promises; these requirements are: to be holy and eternal; nevertheless, Adam lost these requirements when he embraced sin and death and brought them into the whole of creation.

It is impossible for the fallen man, with sin and death, to receive the Lord's promises. God never changed His promises because He is immutable, and His promises are also immutable (Hebrews 6:17-18; 13:8).

God the Father made a promise to Abraham, according to which all nations of the Earth would be blessed in Abraham's Seed; this Seed is Christ, and with His coming, the story of faith and the eternal promises advanced, for the Lord came to confirm them, and in which the Gentiles have participation (Romans 15:8-9). (Genesis 1:1-2).




"And God saw that it was good..." (Genesis 1:10, 12, 18, 21, 25, 31).

From the dust of the holy, pure, and sinless Earth, God formed man in His own image and likeness and breathed into man's nostrils the breath of life. God called his name Adam.



God gave Adam the privilege of serving Him and made a special place for man, the garden in Eden, which Adam had to tend and keep.


The Lord made an everlasting covenant of blessing with Adam; He gave man two holy commandments: to eat of all the trees of the garden, including the Tree of Life; and the commandment of life unto life, by forbidding Adam to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil (Genesis 2:16).



Everything was powerful and glorious; however, something was "not good." Adam had no helper comparable to him, which means "complement" or "part that complements" (Genesis 2:18).

«And the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall on Adam, and he slept; and He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh in its place. Then the rib which the Lord God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man. »

(Genesis 2:21-22).



Adam experienced life, eternity, in his whole being, his body, soul, and spirit, and amid his joy, he saw when the Lord brought him his wife full of eternal life, of holiness. Adam then sang for joy and called his wife "Woman" (Ishshah = wife) because she was taken from the "Man" (Ish = husband) (Genesis 2:23).

All creation was overflowing with joy; it was the flow of life in all its fullness. The Lord God rejoiced in His glorious work. Then He established a mighty mystery: The man shall leave his father and his mother and shall be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh: marriage, and with this, God gave Adam and the wedding gift, three glorious and eternal promises:

Descendants, the Earth, and Government.



«...So the evening and the morning were the sixth day.»


Satan, the old serpent, was not happy at all with God's new creation, nor with the joy that was in it, much less with the new creature that God had formed: Adam, the son of God, to whom everything was given, the dominion over creation. So, the serpent decided to do what it knows to do: deceive...



The devil questioned God's Word and reviled His eternal promises; he deceived the woman, who disobediently opened her ear to the serpent's lies.

The woman sinned, and Adam sinned...

He despised the Word of God, preferred the lie, and chose death, his human wisdom, believing that the tree of the knowledge of good and evil was better than the Tree of Life amid the garden.



Adam and his wife, who received the name "Eve" after sin, surely died. The darkness of sin and death entered God's magnificent creation...

And then, what happened?

Man and woman had no more communion with God. The spirit, soul, and body of Adam and Eve died; death and disease entered the cells of their bodies, the immortal became mortal, they began to become old, and the body, once dead, would rot. The whole creation was subjected to vanity and the bondage of corruption (Romans 8: 20-21).




Adam and Eve were expelled from Eden. What a sad sight! But still, hope shone amid the judgment...

«...And I will put enmity / Between you and the woman, / And between your seed and her Seed; / He shall bruise your head, / And you shall bruise His heel.". » (Genesis 3:15).

God promised the Seed of the woman, which is Christ, who would destroy the one who had the power of death, the devil, the serpent (Hebrews 2:14).

Adam transgressed the covenant (Hosea 6:7); therefore, God gave another sentence before expelling them from Eden. From that moment on, the Lord established that all the promises (the wedding gift) would be under the curse. Eve gave birth in sin, Cain killed his brother Abel, and all the generations after them became depraved...




The wickedness was great on Earth because most men forgot the promises that God gave to Adam, they forgot the consequences of sin and began to walk in their own ways. The Earth was filled with violence, theft, and worst of all, they began to worship creatures as if they were gods.

(Genesis 6: 5-6; Romans 1:20-23)...

What a terrible picture!

Therefore, God sent upon men a terrible judgment, the judgment of the Flood, because they would not hear God's call to repentance and receive the eternal promises...ALL HUMANITY PERISHED IN THIS JUDGMENT, except for a servant named Noah and his household...



Noah found favor in God's sight, and the Lord ratified the Edenic Covenant and its eternal promises to Noah and his family. «So God blessed Noah and his sons, and said to them: "Be fruitful and multiply [promise of the eternal descendants], and fill the earth [promise of the eternal Earth]. And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be on every beast of the earth, on every bird of the air, on all that move on the earth, and on all the fish of the sea. They are given into your hand [promise of the eternal government]...» (Genesis 9:1-2).


However, mankind also violated God's covenant with Noah in the Babel rebellion. God judged them with the Judgment of the confusion of tongues and the dispersion (Genesis 11:1-9). Therefore, God chose and called Abraham, the father of faith, and then, something powerful happened...



«Then He brought him outside and said, "Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them." And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be." » (Genesis 15:5).


«...and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come from you.» (Genesis 17:6).
«Also I give to you and your descendants after you the land in which you are a stranger...» (Genesis 17:8).

God chose Abraham to ratify to him the glorious promises he offered to Adam and his wife in Eden: the main one which is the eternal descendants, and also the eternal Earth and eternal government. Abraham rejoiced and believed with all his heart that he would receive all that was promised, so that this mighty faith was accounted to him for righteousness (Genesis 15:6).




«On the same day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying: "To your descendants I have given this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the River Euphrates— the Kenites, the Kenezzites, the Kadmonites, the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Rephaim, the Amorites, the Canaanites, the Girgashites, and the Jebusites." » (Genesis 15:18-21)

But his faith had to be tested; the day came when God asked Abraham to sacrifice his only begotten son, Isaac, the son of promise. The servant obeyed and from his heart offered everything to the Lord, for he knew that God is able to raise even from the dead (Hebrews 11:19). Because of this faithfulness and obedience, God made a covenant with him under an oath of blessing, where He ratified the promise of the Seed of the woman of the Adamic Covenant...



"By Myself I have sworn, says the Lord, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only son—blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies. In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice."» (Genesis 22:16-18).

God ratified to Isaac and Jacob the powerful promises He made to Abraham. Later, the children of Jacob (Israel) fell into slavery in Egypt. Then, God called Moses to redeem them and give them the Law. All creation was placed under the Law, and the promises were locked up and kept under it; no human being can fulfill the Law by himself. Therefore, it is impossible to receive the promises because of sin. The Law declares all men guilty; thus, the Law leads to Christ (Galatians 3:24).




God ratified the promises He gave Abraham, the same promises confined in the Law Covenant, with another covenant to teach Israel and everyone that His promises are eternal: The Land Covenant.

«Then the Lord your God will bring you to the land which your fathers possessed... He will prosper you and multiply you more than your fathers. And the Lord your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your descendants, to love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, that you may live. »

(Deuteronomy 30:5-6).

But Israel's people apostatized from the faith. They turned away from the Word, violated the covenant of the Law, and rejected faith in the Seed and the eternal promises. Therefore, during the time of the judges, God abandoned Israel and delivered them to their enemies on different occasions; however, the King's mercy was shown on the servants and maidservants who kept the covenant, the remnant of Israel, and even on some Gentiles, such as Ruth...




Ruth, the Gentile, married Boaz (the kinsman redeemer, who represents the Lord Jesus Christ). Thus, she received redemption, inheritance, and eternal promises, and with this, God announced something amazing...

THE COVENANTS AND PROMISES ARE ALSO FOR THE GENTILES!

But if God made the covenant with Israel, the descendants of Abraham, and not with the Gentiles....How is it that they can receive this glorious inheritance too?

«But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. »

(Ephesians 2:13).




God promised Abraham that, in his Seed, all the nations of the Earth would be blessed; this Seed is Christ, the King, who would come to take from the Gentiles a new people for Himself... THE CHURCH

CHRIST MAKES US ENTER INTO HIS COVENANTS SO THAT BOTH JEWS AND GENTILES MAY RECEIVE THE ETERNAL PROMISES!

Paul says that God revealed a mystery hidden for generations, and that is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel (Ephesians 3:6). This body is the holy Church, the bride of Christ, which will first receive the promises given to Israel, but which only the servants, like David, kept in their hearts, beside the covenants of the King. Therefore, they longed to receive the promise God made to Abraham about the coming of the Seed, Christ, for only through Him can the eternal promises be received:

ETERNAL DESCENDANTS, ETERNAL LAND, AND ETERNAL GOVERNMENT.



«I will sing of the mercies of the Lord forever; / With my mouth will I make known Your faithfulness to all generations. For I have said, "Mercy shall be built up forever; / Your faithfulness You shall establish in the very heavens." / "I have made a covenant with My chosen, / I have sworn to My servant David: 'Your seed I will establish forever, / And build up your throne to all generations.'" Selah»


(Psalm 89:1-4).

The servants and maidservants of the Lord kept in their hearts all the promises of God, like Jeremiah and the other prophets, who proclaimed with joy the coming of the Seed (Christ) and the fulfillment of all the covenants and eternal promises, which will be fulfilled for the Church after the Rapture, and for all humanity in the Eternal Kingdom....



But Israel, the chosen people, continued in disobedience, rejecting the eternal promises and apostatizing from the faith and the Word, until the time when the Jews were expelled from the land. The city of Jerusalem and the temple were destroyed and burned, and its inhabitants were put into captivity and servitude for 70 years...

But the King Jesus continued to keep His remnant and provided Himself with servants to whom He revealed His plan. He made His servants understand the prophetic time because they loved the Word and treasured the eternal promises in their hearts. Daniel is one of these servants, who prayed and interceded for the people of Israel that they might not be cast away forever; for this reason, the King sent a very special visit to him.



«At the beginning of your supplications the command went out, and I have come to tell you, for you are greatly beloved; therefore consider the matter, and understand the vision: "Seventy weeks are determined / For your people and for your holy city, / To finish the transgression, / To make an end of sins, / To make reconciliation for iniquity, / To bring in everlasting righteousness, / To seal up vision and prophecy, / And to anoint the Most Holy. »

(Daniel 9:23-24)


God answered the cry of the servant Daniel by sending His angel Gabriel, the messenger of the New Covenant. Gabriel revealed to Daniel a powerful calendar of days and confirmed to the servant the promise of the Seed, the Most Holy, Christ, who would redeem Israel (and all mankind) and give the eternal promises.



This is an amazing calendar, a large part of which has been fulfilled exactly. The angel Gabriel told Daniel that from the day the command was given to restore and build Jerusalem until the Messiah the Prince, Christ, there would be 7 weeks and 62 weeks, that is 483 years. This order was given when, after Israel returned to their land, King Artaxerxes told Nehemiah that he could go and build Jerusalem. (Nehemiah 2:1-10). These 483 years were fulfilled exactly on the day of Christ's Triumphal Entry into the city of Jerusalem.


How marvelous are the power and wisdom of God!

The calendar continued to advance, and the Lord continued to keep His remnant, His holy servants like Daniel, Ezekiel, Ezra, and Nehemiah, who, even during the captivity, remained steadfast, full of the precious faith in the eternal promises, and because of this faith, God fulfilled His Word. After the 70 years of chastening and judgment in Babylon, prophesied by Jeremiah, the Jews returned to Jerusalem with Ezra ...



« Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah might be fulfilled, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, so that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and also put it in writing, saying, Thus says Cyrus king of Persia: All the kingdoms of the earth the LORD God of heaven has given me. And He has commanded me to build Him a house at Jerusalem which is in Judah. Who is among you of all His people? May his God be with him, and let him go up to Jerusalem which is in Judah, and build the house of the LORD God of Israel (He is God), which is in Jerusalem ». (Ezra 1:1-3).

Time passed, and when it came near the fullness of the years that God revealed to his servant Daniel, the Lord sent again His messenger, the angel Gabriel, to give the good news to a maidservant who kept the eternal covenants and mercy. Mary, the maidservant, was chosen as a vessel for the coming of Jesus, the promised Seed to Abraham...




It was necessary that a woman would conceive a child, Christ, and that there should be no participation of any man because it is through the man that sin is transmitted, for Adam violated the covenant, and because of him, the curse, sin, and death entered to humanity and all creation (Romans 5:12, 15, 18-19; 1 Corinthians 15:21). But it was also necessary that the sin, which was in the body and blood of Mary, did not touch the holy Child that would be born; therefore, the power of the Highest overshadowed her....

It was necessary that a pure and holy man, without the sin inherited from Adam, do something to take the sin out of the way; this man is **JESUS**, the last Adam, the Beloved of Heaven, the Firstborn who was brought to the world (Hebrews 1:6), hallelujah! All the angels worshiped Him!



Jesus humbled Himself by taking the form of a bondservant (Philippians 2:6-7), became a little lower than the angels (Psalms 8:5; Hebrews 2:9), took part of flesh and blood (Hebrews 2:14), was begotten among men (Psalm 2:7), in the likeness of sinful flesh (Romans 8:3), because He was born holy and never sinned.

The King fulfilled His powerful ministry for three and a half years. On the appointed day, when the 483 years prophesied by Daniel (Daniel 9:25) were exactly fulfilled, the Most Holy, Messiah the Prince, entered victorious into Jerusalem to fulfill the Father's command, the powerful work of Redemption for Israel, for the Gentiles and for everyone...



(Luke 19:37-38)


Christ is the Seed, and He fulfilled the whole Law, which no human being could fulfill, to give us the promises that were kept in this Law.

He is the Mediator of the New Covenant! (Hebrews 9:15)



«... They shall be My people, and I will be their God; then I will give them one heart and one way, that they may fear Me forever, for the good of them and their children after them. And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from doing them good; but I will put My fear in their hearts so that they will not depart from Me. Yes, I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will assuredly plant them in this land, with all My heart and with all My soul.'» (Jeremiah 32:38-41).

Christ killed sin through the very consequence of men's sin, death (Romans 8:3; 6:4). He bore the sin of all mankind as a substitute, and therefore, He had to die; thus, He destroyed him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, the old serpent that deceived the woman in Eden (Hebrews 2:4). Christ released us from the fear of death, released us from bondage, we were slaves of sin, but He set us free! Hallelujah! (Hebrews 2:15-18).




«And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.»

(Colossians 2:13-15).

But the King did not stop there; He removed the ravages of death with His Resurrection, and through it, as we receive Christ, we are resurrected in both soul and spirit because before we were dead in our trespasses and sins (Ephesians 2:1). However, death is still in our bodies (Romans 8:10)...

CHRIST HAS RAISED!



...but on a glorious day, the trumpet will resound, and those who have fallen asleep with faith in Christ will rise first, and **THEN** our bodies will also be changed and made alive (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17; 1 Corinthians 15:51-52). Christ is the firstfruits to God the Father, and for those who have fallen asleep. He fulfilled the Feast of the Firstfruits of the barley.

The King raised glorified; Christ overcame death forever! He rose never to die again; thus, all of us who believe in Christ will overcome the last enemy, which is death.


«So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: "Death is swallowed up in victory." » (1 Corinthians 15:54).



With this body of glory, Jesus presented Himself to His disciples, and He has promised that in the same way He will also bring those who sleep with faith in Him to gather them with us; those of us who are alive will see the mighty miracle of the Resurrection of life, this is the powerful time of the "THEN" where the Church that is now in Heaven (the brethren who slept), and the Church that is on Earth (those of us who are now breathing and will not see death), will be gathered together (1 Thessalonians 4:13-17).


«Now it came to pass, while He blessed them, that He was parted from them and carried up into heaven.» (Luke 24:51).

After Jesus rose from the dead, He intensely taught His disciples for 40 days. Then, the Lord ascended to Heaven and presented Himself before the Father as a pure offering, and He did this so that we, the Church, may also be raise up into Heaven in the Rapture.



The Church is the only nation that will ascend to the Third Heaven, we will travel through the Universe, we will see the planets and the stars, we will pass through the Second Heaven, the abode of the angels, and we will arrive at the Heavenly City, the New Jerusalem. Only the holy Church will have this privilege thanks to the vicarious work of Christ! (vicarious: substitute). «After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven. And the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, "Come up here...» (Revelation 4:1).

But Israel rejected the Lord, rejected the New Covenant, the people of Israel chose death and rejected life, for which God executed upon them the judgment of forsakenness... Nevertheless, the King's plan was always to take a people from the Jews, who would treasure the promises, and from the Gentiles who, after hearing of these promises, would long for them; this people is **the Church**.



«They have provoked Me to jealousy by what is not God; / They have moved Me to anger by their foolish idols. But I will provoke them to jealousy by those who are not a nation; / I will move them to anger by a foolish nation.»

(Deuteronomy 32:21)


And now the Father has chosen the bride for His beloved Son! And the Beloved has paid the price of blood for His beloved bride (1 Corinthians 6:20; Revelation 5:9). The Beloved returned to the Father's House, where He has prepared a mansion. The Bridegroom says: "I will soon return, to raise you up and take you with me, my beloved, my perfect one, my dove. Can you hear my call? Can you feel my nearness? Have you already anointed yourself, my beloved, my fair one?"



Christ will come quickly to take the glorified Church to the Father's House and, there, take her as His bride forever.

«Who is this coming out of the wilderness / Like pillars of smoke, / Perfumed with myrrh and frankincense, / With all the merchant's fragrant powders?» (Song of Solomon 3:6).


That is why God decided to send a special messenger to confirm the glorious day when the Son will come to take His beloved home... The angel (the Messenger) of the New Covenant, the angel Gabriel, will complete the mission of the announcement of the coming of the Seed (Christ) for His Church in the Rapture...



«...Even the Messenger [mal'âk: angel] of the covenant, / In whom you delight...» (Malachi 3:1).

The Angel Gabriel will announce and confirm the day and hour of the coming of Christ for His holy Church in the Rapture. Hallelujah! It is the day of the Life-Life Memorial!...


This memorable day (the Life-Life Memorial) is the day of eternity when those whose bodies sleep in the dust will arise; these are the children of God who died in Christ, the Glorious Ones who will sing The Melody of The Calling; it is the melody of the love of Christ for the Church.



«Your dead shall live; / Together with my dead body they shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust; / For your dew is like the dew of herbs, / And the earth shall cast out the dead. »

(Isaiah 26: 19)

Those who slept in Christ are the Ekklesia in New Jerusalem. Therefore, the Church of the beginnings of this dispensation and all the saints who persevered until the last breath will come to this Earth, and the powerful time of the "THEN" will happen.



The Time of "THEN" will last three days, and we (the Church that still breathes and will have remained) will be gathered to the Glorious Ones; we will see the glory of life in our brethren who had departed to Heaven. They, with us, will fulfill the last mission of being witnesses of the Gospel of the unsearchable riches of Christ (Acts 1:8; Ephesians 3:8); La glorified Church, with us, will preach the Good News throughout the Earth to gather the fullness of the Gentiles and complete the Holy Church. The Glorious Ones will say, "Yes, the day and hour of the Rapture of the Church is known, hallelujah, yes, there is resurrection, yes, there are eternal promises!"

When the Church is complete, the most glorious event in all of human history will take place: Those of us who are still breathing will be glorified, our bodies will be transformed into the likeness of the body of our Lord Jesus (Philippians 3:21). Thus, we will make the most amazing journey we have ever made, we will come up to the clouds, we will travel through the First and Second Heavens to arrive home, the New Jerusalem in the Third Heaven, where Christ has already prepared our mansions. How powerful!



"For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable." (Romans 11:29)




«Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and His ways past finding out!» (Romans 11:33)



With this Marriage, the New Covenant that the King announced on the day He supped with His disciples in the Upper Room will be sealed.




BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!

(Jeremiah 30:10-11).




(Isaiah 61:9).

During the Millennial Kingdom, the mortals of Israel will serve God in the Millennial Temple; they will finally obey from their hearts all the instructions of the Law Covenant; thus, the children of Jacob, the glorified Church, and all the nations will celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles from year to year in the partially restored Earth of the Millennial Kingdom...

The Eternal Kingdom



The center of this Kingdom is the holy descendants multiplied eternally, which is the main promise given in the Scriptures from Genesis (Genesis 1: 22) to Revelation (Revelation 22:3); this descendants are the Worshippers Rivers who will worship the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit in spirit and in truth (John 4:23).




This promise of the holy descendants multiplied in the Eternal Kingdom is the one the Lord told to His servant Jeremiah, when He said:

«...then I will give them one heart and one way, that they may fear Me forever, for the good of them and their children after them.» (Jeremiah 32:39).


This promise was written by the servant Paul in the book of Hebrews, look at what the Lord said....

«For when God made a promise to Abraham, because He could swear by no one greater, He swore by Himself, saying, "Surely blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply you."...that by two immutable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie...» (Hebrews 6:13-14, 18; cf. Genesis 22:17). These two immutable things are: the blessing and the holy descendants multiplied eternally, which are the sure and steadfast anchor of the soul of the holy Church, we, those who have believed and treasured this mighty hope. Hallelujah! (Hebrews 6:13-20).



Christ is the High Priest of the good things to come (Hebrews 9:11-12), the promised Seed of Adam (Genesis 3:15) and Abraham (Genesis 22:18). Jesus entered for us into the Most Holy Place as forerunner, to give us these powerful promises, because by His powerful redeeming work He made us children of God, and if children, then joint heirs with Christ (Romans 8:17). These promises are also for Israel and the saved humanity, whose fulfillment for them will be in the Eternal

In the Eternal Kingdom, all the eternal promises of the eight covenants will be fulfilled. The main one of all promises is the holy descendants, who will multiply forever and ever to populate the New Earth and the New Heavens, which will be endlessly expanded. These descendants are the rivers of worshippers who will sing the mercies of God from generation to generation (Psalms 89:1). This is how the King planned it from the beginning with Adam because nothing can stop His plans. Hallelujah!



These glorious promises are what the King is offering you, and He invites you to receive them. He made eternal covenants, swearing by Himself, to guarantee and keep these promises. Because of them, Christ came as the last Adam to confirm them; He died and rose again as a man, taking our place, to grant us these promises: the eternal descendants, the eternal New Earth and New Heavens, and the eternal government. We will enjoy all this in the expanded Empire that will have no end (Isaiah 9:7), the Empire of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, where Christ is the King of kings because this story will continue eternally and forever, forever and ever, Hallelujah!



And you, if you are not yet part of the beloved bride of the King, the Church, the Lord tells you to repent of your sins and receive Him into your heart; He tells you: "Enter into my New Covenant, be saved, throw yourself into my arms, abide in my Love, which is my Word and receive the delights of my glory". If you had already received Christ, but you turned away from Him because of unbelief, the Beloved says to you today: "You can still repent of having left me, of having rejected my eternal promises, of having violated the New Covenant. Turn your feet to my ways and receive my mercy for salvation".....And if the Church, the bride, has already departed to go to the Marriage of the Lamb, and you remained in the Tribulation, you still have the opportunity to receive salvation and all the eternal promises: holy descendants multiplied eternally, eternal government and New Heavens and Earth. The Lord says to those who will suffer in the terrible time of Tribulation: "Repent of your sins, look unto me, for I am your help, I am your hope of glory, persevere and overcome, as my beloved Church overcame..."If you want this glorious inheritance, pray this simple prayer with all your heart:
