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INTRODUCTION

In this booklet, you will find a powerful prayer plan for the End Times. The Lord gave His Church precise instructions on what to do when Her departure to the New Jerusalem at the Rapture approaches. And within these instructions-commands are to pray, cry out, groan, and war in spiritual warfare.

Prayer is a Biblical commandment; Jesus said: «Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed *is* willing, but the flesh *is* weak.» (Matthew 26:41). In 1 Thessalonians 5:17 says: «pray without ceasing...» There are many verses where we find this commandment of prayer, and it is also our need to talk with our God and worship Him. There are two main prayer instructions; let us see:

(a) The first is to pray with faith. James 1:6-8 says: «But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; *he is* a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.»

But it's necessary to clarify that the faith that James and all the Scriptures speak of is the incorruptible faith centered in eternity; it is the faith described in Hebrews chapter 11 and defined in verse 1 this way: «Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.»

This chapter details the meaning of "things hoped for" and "things not seen," it is the New Jerusalem with all the eternal promises. This faith is confirmed in Hebrews 11: 8-10 when it says: «By faith obeyed when he was called to go out to **the place which he would receive as an inheritance**. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as *in* a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise; **for he waited for the city which has foundations**, whose builder and maker *is* God. » (Highlighted by the authors).

Nowadays, the devil has changed the living Biblical faith of Hebrews 11 for a corruptible faith, for the ephemeral, vain, and earthly things.

In the same way, the devil has changed the prayer because many churches are crying out for the earthly, material, and ephemeral things. What we described before has happened because they have forgotten the Word of God and changed it for the word of men full of heart's desires, full of the lust of the flesh.

(b) The second instruction for prayer that the Bible gives us is that we must pray according to God's will. 1 John 5: 14-15 says: «Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.» We can't pray for everything we imagine because the old nature, which is corrupted according to deceitful lusts, always wants to impose her desires, the lusts of the flesh.

It is necessary to know the will of God so that we can pray according to what He wants, and we know that His will is good, acceptable, and perfect (Romans 12:2; 1 John 5:14). The way to know the Lord's will is through His Word, which enables us to be transformed by the renewing of our minds. In the same way, the Holy Spirit guides and leads us to reject the world so that we do not conform to the evil age from which God has delivered us (Galatians 1:4).

The apostasy of the Church is the abandonment of the biblical faith and the Word of God. The apostates preach and teach that we can ask God everything we want in prayer, according to the human will, but this belief is false. Sadly, many have believed this lie and corrupted prayer by turning it into a means of obtaining earthly goods. Consequently, all those who attend the apostate Church are not warned about the End Times we are living in; they haven't realized that these End Times events that are about to happen: The Rapture of the Church, the judgment of the 7 years of Tribulation, at the end of which the Millennial Kingdom of the Lord Jesus Christ will begin, and when this period ends, there will be the judgment upon the nations (who will rebel against Christ at the end of the Millennium), and judgment upon Satan, the demons, and the judgment on the present Heavens and Earth will occur. Finally, there will be judgment before the Great White Throne, where all lost human beings will go, those who never repented and rejected the Word of God and the living Christ.

The Lord has established in His Word that the holy Church will pray intensely for all the events mentioned above. However, most of the Church is distracted by the world and the earthly things at the end time. Thanks to the Lord, there's a remnant that is faithful to God, and it is fulfilling the command to pray with the biblical faith (centered on eternal life). This remnant cries out according to God's will and is making intercession earnestly for the fulfillment of the Word of God and the conversion of the souls because the Lord will gather the cleaned wheat to take them very soon to the house of the Father, the New Jerusalem, on the day of Rapture.

The Holy Church must wait for the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ, praying in the Holy Spirit (Jude 1: 20-21). The Church must always make all kinds of prayers and supplications through the Spirit without ceasing (Ephesians 6:18; 1 Thessalonians 5:17).

In this prayer plan that we present you, you will pray according to the will of God written in His Word; you will pray with the motives of prayer that the Lord gave in the Scriptures, and you will pray with the living, precious, eternal, and glorious faith of Hebrews 11, which looks toward eternity.

This prayer plan is not only for the holy Church that is about to be raptured but also for those who will live the Tribulation judgment, a time of trouble in which prayer will sustain all those who repent of their sins and receive Jesus in their hearts as the only Lord, Savior, and God, believing with all their heart in Him.

The following are some motives of prayer, which are implicitly or explicitly included in the steps of the prayer plan we offer below; the Bible teaches that we must:

1. Pray for the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ in the Rapture. Revelation 22:17 says that the Holy Spirit and the Church, the Lamb's Bride, will join in groaning to say, "Come Lord Jesus!" In Revelation 22:20, this cry is reiterated "Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!"

2. Watch and pray to know the day and the hour of the coming of Christ for His Church. The Lord Jesus Christ ordered the Church to take heed of the signs of the End Times to know the time of His coming for her (Mark 13:33); He also ordered the Church to watch and pray because she didn't know the day and the hour of the Rapture (Matthew 24: 36,42). However, the Lord said that He would come as a thief in the night, not to His holy Church, but to those who dwell on the Earth and the apostate Church that was already cut off in the judgment of forsakenness (2 Thessalonians 2: 1-3), for she is dead, and only the dead Church, will not know the hour of Jesus' return (Revelation 3:1-2), the Church of the evil servants that wouldn't be looking for the day and the hour of the coming of the Lord (Matthew 24:50; Luke 12:46). On the other hand, the Lord told the holy Church, whose members are sons of day and light, that His coming would not surprise her like a thief in the night; on the contrary, that she would know the time, the day and the hour (1 Thessalonians 5:1-5.). This is confirmed when the Lord Jesus said that if the master of the house knew the hour, and therefore the day, when the thief would come, he would keep watch (Matthew 24:42- 43). The Lord commanded the Church to watch; therefore, He promised her that the Holy Spirit would make her understand the time, day and hour of His coming for her; because He would guide her into all truth and teach her all things. (John 14:26; John 16:13-16).

3. Pray that the name of the Lord may be hallowed in all the Earth (Matthew 6: 9). This motive of prayer means to pray for the judgments of the Tribulation so that the Millennial Kingdom will come, in which God will be worshiped in every nation of the Earth. The request to sanctify the name of the Lord is also a prayer for the coming of the Eternal Kingdom, in which all will be holy and glorify the living God; there will be no sinners.

4. Pray for the Lord's will may be done in all the Earth (Matthew 6: 10), which also implies praying for the judgments of the Tribulation to come so that the will of God may be imposed in all the Earth, and this will happen in the Millennial Kingdom and the Eternal Kingdom.

5. Pray that we may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass (Luke 21:36); this petition refers to the Lord Jesus' command to cry out to be delivered from the judgment of the Tribulation.

6. Pray to be patient concerning the coming of the Lord (James 5:7; Romans 8:24-25; 15: 4; Hebrews 10: 35-39). The Bible teaches that the Church that would be about to be raptured to the New Jerusalem would enter in a time of patience. In this time, she would be strengthened by keeping the Word of perseverance (Revelation 3.10); which would allow her to be delivered from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world, that is the Tribulation Judgment.

7. Pray to be sober (1 Thessalonians 5:6; 1 Peter 4:7; 5:8). This means to live without greed and covetousness for material things. The apostate churches covet earthly goods; therefore, they don't want Christ to come in the Rapture, nor do they want the Kingdom of God on Earth in the Millennium and the Eternal Kingdom.

8. Pray for the Kingdom of God to come to this Earth (Matthew 6:10), which implies praying for the judgments of the Tribulation to come to cleanse the Earth contaminated with sin: when we read: "Your Kingdom come," this refers to the Millennial Kingdom of Christ and the Eternal Kingdom.

9. Pray to be vigilant to resist the devil (1 Peter 5:8; Ephesians 6:11; James 4:7).

10. Pray that we may be filled with the knowledge of God's will (Colossians 1:9).

11. Pray for being strengthened in the inner man by the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 3:14-16).

12. Pray for the repentance of people whom God knows but who are lost in apostate churches (James 5:19-20).

13. Pray that Christ may continue to dwell in the hearts of believers (Ephesians 3: 14, 17).

14. Pray that the Lord may give us the spirit of wisdom and revelation so that He may enlighten our knowledge and so give us spiritual understanding; so that we can comprehend the eternal promises (Ephesians 1: 16-19).

15. Pray for the fellowship in the Gospel (being in unity) (Philippians 1: 3-5).

16. Pray for love may abound in knowledge and all discernment (Philippians 1:9).

17. Pray for the Word of the Lord may run swiftly and be glorified (2 Thessalonians 3:1).

18. Pray for all the brethren in the faith of the holy Church who are in all the Earth (Ephesians 6:18).

19. Pray in war against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, and spiritual hosts of wickedness in high places (Ephesians 6:11-12). This motive of prayer is found in all the imprecatory Psalms, which are a model for us.

All these motives of prayer described above are Biblical, and if you haven't used them, you will realize that you haven't prayed after God's will. However, it is time for you to arise and pray according to the Word of God, as the Lord commanded us to cry out, groan, war, and always pray with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit. In the pages that follow, you'll find fifteen prayer steps for the End Times, according to God's will, so that you may be in His presence and fulfill His command:

1. A prayer with the Psalms. Praying with the Psalms.

In this plan step, you will learn to pray like the servants who wrote the Psalms, such as Moses, David, Asaph, and others. You must read each Psalm with an attitude of prayer to the Lord, believing He is listening to the cry you make with His Word. Begin your prayer like this:

Read aloud 9 Psalms, starting from chapters 1-9. When you return to this step of the plan, after having finished the others, continue with the reading of Psalms 10-18 and so on each time you complete all the steps of the prayer plan.

While reading and praising, let the Holy Spirit guide the prayer. During this reading, worship, and praise time, you must pray, cry out, groan, and war.

2. A prayer of war. Praying with warfare passages and worship songs.

We have a wrestle against the hell hierarchy, against the world and the Perverse old nature, the old man, the flesh; therefore, we must stand up in spiritual warfare, using God's Word and His praises, the sung Word of God, to overthrow all enemies. When you read this prayer plan, if the Church has already gone to the New Jerusalem in the Rapture, you must know that you are in the judgment of the Tribulation and that the Antichrist has already manifested himself. As a result, there will be an explosion of evil and the hierarchy of Hell as there has never been before with terrible deceiving spirits. This is why you will have to pray as the psalmists did. In step 1, you have already seen how they prayed. In this step number 2, continue to exercise yourself in the prayer of war. Begin your prayer like this:

Read the biblical warfare passages: 2 Samuel 22: 31-43. Psalms 3; 5; 7; 10; 12; 17: 6-15; 28: 7-9; 35; 44; 54; 55; 59; 68; 109; 140; 141. Isaiah 14: 1-23. Ezekiel 28: 1-19. Romans 13: 11-14. 2 Corinthians 10: 3-5. Ephesians 1: 19-23; 4: 22-27; 6: 10-18. Colossians 2: 8-15. James 4:7. 1 Peter 5: 8-11. 1 John 5: 1-5.

During this reading, worship, and praise time, you must pray, cry out, groan, and war.

PRAY, CRY OUT, GROAN, WAR.

3. A prayer of worship and glory to the King. Praying with praises that exalt the attributes and works of the King.

Praise and worship are powerful weapons for pulling down our enemies and strongholds. We confirmed this when the people of Israel entered the promised land through Jericho, the priests blew the trumpets, and the city walls fell when the people shouted (Joshua 6: 4-20). We also confirmed the power of praise when Jehoshaphat told the Levites to praise the Lord, and after they did so, their enemies were defeated (2 Chronicles 20: 17-22). David knew that praise and worship were powerful weapons against the enemy, so he wrote by the Holy Spirit imprecatory psalms and songs. With these, God gave him victory. Begin your prayer like this:

Read the passages and verses of praise to the Lord: Psalms 33; 86; 95; 96; 103; 145; 146. 2 Samuel 7: 21-24. 1 Chronicles 16: 7-36; 29: 11. 2 Chronicles 6: 13-42. Isaiah 25: 1-9. Habakkuk 3: 17-19. Romans 11: 33-36. 2 Corinthians 1: 3-4. Ephesians 3: 14-21. 1 Timothy 1:17. 2 Peter 3: 18. Revelation 5: 8-14; 19: 1-8.

4. A prayer for the Eternal Promises. Praying with the eternal promises of God.

The Lord gave powerful, eternal promises that no one has yet received. The Bible teaches that the Old Testament saints attained them but did not receive them. The brethren of the Church who are asleep have obtained the promises; nevertheless, they will receive them at the Rapture (Hebrews 11: 13, 33, 39-40). None of the eternal promises has been fulfilled, for the requirement of the receptors of such promises is to be eternal, immortal, holy, and sinless. Therefore, the first ones who will receive the fulfillment of the promises will be the children of God, the Church, at the time of the fulfillment of the promises, when she will be resurrected and glorified. These promises are: holy descendants multiplied for eternity, the New Earth and New Heavens, the New Jerusalem, and the eternal government and priesthood.

At this step of the plan, you will pray for the fulfillment of these promises, which are about to be received. Begin your prayer like this:

Read the passages and verses about God's eternal promises: Genesis 12: 1-8; 15; 17; 22:1-18. Exodus 32: 11-14. 2 Samuel 7: 18-20. 1 Chronicles 29: 10- 15. Psalms 23; 45; 72; 84; 87; 102. Isaiah 54; 60; 61; 65. Matthew 19: 27-30. Romans 4; Galatians 3; 4. Ephesians 1: 11-14, 18. Colossians 1: 9-14. Hebrews 6:13-20; 9: 11-15; 10: 1-25, 34-39; 12: 26-29. 1 Peter 1: 3-5. Revelation 2; 3; 19: 1-10; 20: 1-8; 21.

5. A prayer for the Blessed Hope. Praying for the coming of the King for His Church.

The Lord revealed the time of His coming and told the Church to pray for this glorious event to occur in which she will be resurrected, glorified, and raptured to the Third Heaven, the New Jerusalem. The Lord Jesus Christ will come, and we will be taken up into the clouds after being transformed. The coming of the Lord in the Rapture is the manifestation of His glory, and with it, the obtaining of eternal promises is the blessed hope (Titus 2.13). We long for those glories for which God has prepared us.

At this plan step, you will feel the fire in your heart for the coming of Christ at the Rapture. You will be like the Shulamite woman of Song of Solomon, seeking the bridegroom with all her heart. Begin your prayer like this:

☐ Read passages and verses about the coming of the King: Psalm 16: 11; 17: 15; 27: 5-6; 42; 63. Song of Solomon 2: 7-13. Isaiah 26: 19-20. Daniel 12: 2. John 14: 1-3. 6. A prayer of gratitude. Praying in thanksgiving to the Lord.

The Lord has given so much to mankind and His children, that's why we should give thanks. The main reason to thank Him is this great and undeserved salvation. The human being sinned and deserved Hell, deserved to be definitively rejected, but God did not do this. He provided grace through Jesus Christ so that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life (John 3:16).

Besides this eternal salvation, the Lord has not invalidated His covenants and promises but will fulfill them. Hallelujah! Let us pray and praise the King by giving Him thanks. Begin your prayer like this:

☐ Read passages of thanksgiving: 1 Chronicles 16: 7-36. Psalm 16; 18; 20; 26: 6 -8; 30; 66; 92; 98; 100; 103; 110; 118; 136; 138; 139. Daniel 2: 20-23. Romans 1: 8; 6: 16-18. 1 Corinthians 1: 3-9; 15: 57. 2 Corinthians 4: 14-16. Ephesians 1: 1-14; 5:19- 20. Philippians 4: 4-7. Colossians 2: 6-10; 4: 2. 1 Thessalonians 5: 16-24. 1 Timothy 1: 12-17. 7. A prayer of judgment and mercy. Praying for God's justice and repentance.

The Lord will judge all unbelieving mankind in the seven years of Tribulation already at the door. However, during this time, He will extend His mercy upon the world's inhabitants and Israel for conversion. The terrible judgment events will bring many to repentance (Revelation 7: 9-17). We must pray for these judgments to come and for the Earth to be cleansed from sin and many abominations because then the Lord Jesus Christ will come to reign over the Earth and bring everlasting righteousness. The psalmists and the prophets prayed for these judgments, and the Church must do the same. Begin your prayer like this:

□ Read the passages and verses about judgment and the imprecatory Psalms: Numbers 14: 11-24. Psalm 9; 18; 21; 50; 59; 70; 75; 76; 79; 94; 129; 140; 149. Isaiah 24; 29; 34; 47; 55: 1-13. Jeremiah 14; 51: 13-37. Daniel 9: 20-27. Joel 3: 1- 15. Zephaniah 1. Zechariah 12: 1-14; 14: 1-9. Malachi 3: 1-5; 4: 1-6. Matthew 24. Mark 13. Luke 21:5-36. Romans 9: 15-22; 11: 32 - 33. 2 Peter 3: 8-14. Revelation 15: 4; 16: 1- 21; 19: 11-21; 20.

8. A prayer for the eternal covenants. Praying with the biblical covenants.

God, in His omniscience and foreknowledge, knew that Adam was going to sin and, therefore, sin would have devastating consequences, such as: (a) sin and death would enter all creation; (b) the offspring would be born corrupt, with original sin and death. Having known this, the Lord decided to give His eternal promises within eternal covenants. He promised to fulfill them, for He swore for Himself by His faithfulness, grace, love, and truth.. The first covenant was the Edenic covenant when Adam had not sinned; then the Lord made seven more covenants; the last covenant is the New Covenant, in which Christ, the last Adam, consummated His redemptive work to give us salvation and eternal promises. As all the covenants are eternal, God will fulfill them all with its promises. Let us pray that all covenants will be fulfilled soon. Begin your prayer like this:

(1) Edenic Covenant: Genesis 1: 6-28; 2: 7-25. Isaiah 24: 1-6. Hosea 6: 7. Malachi 2: 14-15. Matthew 19: 4-6. Ephesians 5: 28-32.

(2) Adamic Covenant: Genesis 3: 8-24. Romans 8: 20-22.

(3) Noahic Covenant: Genesis 9: 1-17.

(4) Abrahamic Covenant: Genesis 12: 1-9; 13: 14-17; 15: 1-21; 17: 1-21; 18: 1-15; 22: 1-18.

(5) Law Covenant: Exodus 19: 3-6; 24:1-18. Deuteronomy 7: 6- 13; 28: 1-14.

(6) Land Covenant: Deuteronomy 29: 1-29.

(7) Davidic Covenant: 1 Chronicles 17: 7-27. Psalm 89: 1-37.

(8) New Covenant: Jeremiah 31: 27-40; 32: 37-42; 33:6-18. Matthew 26: 26-29. John 13: 1- 4, 31-35; 14: 1-3.

9. A prayer of Faith. Praying for faith.

In the introduction of this prayer plan, we spoke about the true faith, the biblical faith, the faith of Hebrews 11, and the living, precious, and eternal faith that leads us to the New Jerusalem. We need to pray for this faith so that we may hold on to it and that it be strengthened every day while we are on this pilgrimage that is about to end. But we also need to pray that others may receive this biblical faith and reject the corruptible faith that apostates have preached to them. The faith that the King gives us and teaches us in His Word has the following purposes: (a) for salvation (Romans 1:16); (b) to please God (Hebrews 11:6); (c) to make us able to be rapture (Hebrews 10:35-39); (d) to obtain eternal promises. Christ suffered, died, and rose again to give us this powerful and precious faith centered in eternity. Therefore, He is the author and finisher of faith (Hebrews 12:2), for His sacrifice on the cross of Calvary offers us the blessing of obtaining His eternal promises. Let us pray for this faith! Begin your prayer like this:

□ Read the passages and verses about Faith: Romans 1: 16-17; 4: 5-24; 15: 13. 2 Corinthians 4: 7-18. Ephesians 1: 17-23. 1 Timothy 6: 11-16. 2 Timothy 4: 7-8. Hebrews 4: 1-13; 6: 11-20; 10: 21-39; 11; 12: 1-2. James 1: 2-8. 1 Peter 1: 3-9, 14-21; 5: 6- 11. 2 Peter 1: 1-5. 1 John 5: 1-5. Jude 1: 20-25.

10. A prayer for the Father’s house. Praying for setting our minds on the New Jerusalem.

Our goal is to be in the New Jerusalem, in the Father's house, where we have our whole heart, our longing, and our sight; this is the promise the Lord gave to His Church when He said to His disciples at the beginning of the Upper Room discourse, affirming that He was the way (John 14:1-4). The holy Church will depart to the heavenly city in the Rapture; afterward, the Tribulation will begin, and during this dreadful period, the promise of the Father's house will also be the hope that will strengthen the hearts of many because, at the end of this period of judgment, the Lord Jesus will come for a second time to reign for a thousand years over the Earth. After the final judgments, the glorious event of the creation of the New Heavens and the New Earth will take place, to which the beloved city, the New Jerusalem, will descend (Revelation 21). Begin your prayer like this:

□ Read the passages and verses about the Father’s house, the New Jerusalem: Psalms: 17: 13-15; 26: 6-8; 27: 4-5, 13-14; 36: 7-9; 42: 1-3; 43: 3-5; 48; 73: 24-28; 84; 87. Isaiah 30: 18- 19. Jeremiah 51: 58. Habakkuk 2: 13. Matthew 15: 17. John 6: 27; 14: 1-4. Romans 16: 17- 18. 1 Corinthians 2: 9; 6: 13-14; 7: 29-31. 2 Corinthians 4: 17-18; 5: 1-3. Colossians 3: 1-4. 11. A prayer against fear. Praying to cast out fear.

The Lord tells us not to fear, not to be afraid. He commands us to have a reverent fear of Him, which is fear of worship and praise to Him (Isaiah 8:13; Matthew 10:24-31). Difficulties and sufferings of all kinds may come, but the Almighty God, *El Shaddai*, is with us. God told Abraham not to be afraid because His reward would be exceedingly great (Genesis 15:1). This reward is the presence of God for eternity and His glorious eternal promises. The Lord said that one of the attacks on the Church before the Rapture would be fear; so, in John 14.1 and 27, He told us not to trouble our hearts, but to believe in God.

Very soon, the Church will already have gone to Heaven in the Rapture. Then, the Tribulation will begin, and during those seven years, there will be much fear, terror, and dread because of the terrifying events that will take place (Luke 21:26). But those who receive Christ in their hearts will have peace and strength through the Holy Spirit and God's powerful Word. In this step of the plan, you will experience joy, safety, peace, and strength from God. Begin your prayer like this:

☐ Read the passages and verses to cast out fear: Genesis 15: 1; 26: 24. Exodus 14: 13-14. Joshua 1: 9. 2 Chronicles 20: 15-22; 32: 7-8. Psalms: 3; 27; 34: 4; 46: 1-3; 49: 5; 56; 61; 64: 1-2; 91; 118: 5-9. Isaiah 8: 11- 13; 12: 1-6; 35: 3-4; 41: 9-14; 43: 1-5; 44: 6-8; 51: 6-13; 54: 4-5. Matthew 8: 23-27; 10: 24-31. John 14: 1-3, 26-27. Romans 8: 14-16. Hebrews 13: 5- 6. 1 Peter 3:14. 1 John 4: 18. Revelation 2: 10.

12. A prayer for the Second Coming of Christ.

The Lord also commanded us to pray for His Second Coming, when He will come to this Earth and stand His feet on the Mount of Olives. The Church has prayed for the Rapture and all the judgments, and even though she will be resurrected and taken to the New Jerusalem before the Tribulation begins, the Church has also prayed for the glorious event when the Lord Jesus will come a second time with His Church, to reign for a thousand years. If the Rapture of the holy Church has already happened -and you're in the middle of the Tribulation Judgment-. In that case, this prayer for the Second Coming of Christ will be your strength. This prayer for Christ's Second Coming will be your strength. Cry out every day and count the days because the Lord said that from the day when the Antichrist confirms the covenant between Israel and the Arab nations, the Tribulation Judgment will begin, which will last seven years formed by prophetic days: 42 months in the first half of the Tribulation Judgment and 42 months in the last half, with months of 30 days according to the prophecy of Daniel 9. This time is also equivalent to two halves of 1260 days each, for a total of 2520 days. Surely, when these days are finished, the Lord Jesus Christ will come with great power and glory (Luke 21:27). Begin your prayer like this:

13. Praying for the glorified body: for the adoption and redemption of our body. Praying to be made alive.

The promise of the glorified body is included in step 5 of this plan when we spoke about the glorious manifestation of Christ's coming through His holy Church in the Rapture and the blessed hope of eternal promises. But we have decided to add the cry for "the adoption of the body" to make a special groaning because the Lord is about to come for His Church, and it is necessary to intensify the cry.

In the same way, when the Church has been raptured, those who were left behind in the Tribulation will need to groan, cry out for the resurrection, and pray for the vivification and glorification of the body. This is what will happen to the saved during the Tribulation, with the Second Coming of Christ. Begin your prayer like this:

□ Read the passages and verses: Job 19: 25-27. Psalm 119: 25, 40, 88, 107, 149, 156, 159. Isaiah 26:19. Hosea 6: 1-3; 14: 7. John 6: 39-54. Romans 8: 11, 15, 17, 23, 30. 1 Corinthians 15:22-54. 2 Corinthians 3: 6-11.

14. Praying to overcome the Old Nature.

This war against the flesh is included in step 2 of this plan, "A prayer of war." Still, we have decided to add a special step because the Bible teaches that the last enemy that will be destroyed is death, whose sting is sin, the flesh, the old nature, the Perverse. The Church's last enemy would be the flesh because the holy Church would overcome Satan, the wicked one, through the powerful Word of God (John 2: 13-14). The Church would also overcome the world through the living and precious faith of Hebrews 11 (1 John 5:4; Hebrews 11: 1). Therefore, the last war the Church would wage before the resurrection, glorification, and Rapture to the New Jerusalem would be against the Perverse, the old Nature, the old man, the flesh; this is the calendar we see in the book of Romans chapters 7 and 8. Likewise, during the Millennium, the only enemy that the non-glorified Millennial inhabitants will have one enemy, which is the flesh, the Perverse, the sinful nature, because Satan will be bound in the bottomless pit, and there will be no worldly structure on Earth. The non-glorified Millennial inhabitants will have to pray and cry out to overcome the war against the flesh as the Church did and overcame, and like the victory of those who will receive Christ, be saved and endure to the end of the Tribulation judgment. Begin your prayer like this:

□ Read the passages and verses: Romans 6: 6-14; 7: 13-25; 8: 1-14; 13:13-14. 1 Corinthians 1: 25-31; 9: 24-27; 15: 50. 2 Corinthians 7: 1; 10: 3-5. Galatians 3: 1-3; 5: 13, 16-26; 6: 7-8. Ephesians 2: 1-3; 4: 22-27. Philippians 3: 3-14. Colossians 2: 23; 3: 5-10. 1 Peter 2: 11; 4: 2. 2 Peter 2: 10, 17-18. 1 John 2: 16-17.

15. A cry for the Word of God: Praying for being enlightened to understand the Word of God.

The apostles, especially Paul, prayed permanently for the following motives: (a) that the brethren in the churches might receive the enlightenment of the Holy Spirit so they could understand the Scriptures, the Mystery of Christ; (b) that their understanding might be enlightened, that they might know the riches of the glory of Christ; (c) that they might see clearly the hope to which God called them; (d) that they might understand what their salvation consist, His redeeming work, why and for what purpose the Lord died; (e) that they might understand the eternal inheritance, the Eternal Kingdom, the eternal promises. In this way, believers would not be deceived by apostasy, by false doctrines that tried to turn them away from the sincere faithfulness to Christ, from the glorious Gospel. These deceivers attempted to make the believers take their eyes and hearts off on the eternal things, the good things to come so that they would be centered and rooted in this Earth, in corruptible things, in the world.

In this step of the plan, you will be able to cry out for the Word of God to understand it with all wisdom and spiritual understanding so that you might understand all things that eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered the heart of man. You will know them through the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 2:9-10). Begin your prayer like this:

Read the passages and verses: Psalms 119. 1 Corinthians 2:6-16. Ephesians 1:15-23. Colossians 1: 9-14. 1 Peter 1:3-12.

Why BEREA Church

We are called BEREA Christian Church Because we respond to the Father’s demands who seeks worshipers in spirit and true (John 4:23-24); and we base on the permanent study of the Bible, as Bereans did who searched every day the Scripture (Acts 17:11).

- That salvation and eternal life can only be had through: genuine repentance of sins, believing in Jesus as the only and sufficient Savior, receiving Him in the heart, confessing Him, and leading a life of holiness in obedience to the Bible (Acts 2:38, 3:19. Romans 10:9-10. Hebrews 12:14).

- In the baptism of the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking with tongues (Acts 2:1-13; 10: 44-46).
- In the gifts of the Holy Spirit active in the Church today, for her edification as a body (Romans. 12: 6 - 8. 1 Corinthians 12: 8 - 10): gifts of healings, of working miracles, of knowledge, of wisdom, of prophecy, discernment of spirits, speaking with tongues, interpretation of tongues, service, teaching, exhortation, among others.
- That God left ministries in the Church: apostles (missionaries, Church planters in the world), prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers (Ephesians 4:11-12).
- In the Rapture of the Church before the Tribulation (1 Corinthians 15: 51-54; 1 Thessalonians 1:10, 4:13-18; Revelation 3:10. Luke 21:36. John 14:1-3).
- In the prophetic 7-year judgment of the Tribulation or seventieth week of Daniel (Daniel 9: 27; Revelation chaps. 6-16; Matthew 24: 1-29; Mark 13: 1-25; Luke 21:5-26).
- In that after the 7 years of Tribulation, Jesus will come to Earth for the second time with His glorified Church (Matthew 24: 30-31; Mark 13: 26-27; Luke 21:27; Zechariah 14: 4; Revelation 19: 11-21).
- That after His second coming, Christ will reign 1,000 years on Earth (Revelation 20:1-10; Isaiah 65:20).
- In Heaven where all those who are saved in Christ, and obeys His Gospel, goes at death; and in Hell as a real place where everyone who reject Christ and do not live according to His Gospel will go (Matthew 5:22,29,30, 10:28, 18:9, 23:33; Mark 9:43,45,47; Luke 12:5; 2 Peter 2:4; Revelation 20:15, 21:8; Luke 16:23-24).
- In the New Jerusalem, the Heavenly City, the city of the Living God to which the Church will go when it is raptured by Jesus (Hebrews 11:10,16; 12:22. Revelation 21:9-27).
- In which God will make New Heavens and a New Earth, where the New Jerusalem will come down (Isaiah 65:17-19; Revelation ch. 21).
- In that God made eternal covenants with glorious promises that will be fulfilled first in the Church when she will be glorified, and in Israel and the nations in the Eternal Kingdom. These promises are: the holy descendants, multiplied eternally; the eternal government (reign and priesthood) and the extended Earth for eternity: Edenic Covenant (Gen 1: 6-28; Hos 6:7); Adamic Covenant (Gen 3: 8-24. Rom 8: 20-22); Noahic Covenant (Gen 9: 1-17); Abrahamic Covenant (Gen 22: 1-18); Law Covenant (Deut 28: 1- 14); Land Covenant (Deut 29:1-29); Davidic Covenant (1 Chron 17: 7-27); New Covenant (Jer 31: 27-40).
