


In hell, lost people will suffer ignominy and despise: This is another characteristic of Hell. Isaiah 66:24 says: «“And they shall go forth and look / Upon the corpses of the men / Who have transgressed against Me / For their worm does not die, / And their fire is not quenched. / They shall be an abhorrence to all flesh.”» The condemned people will hate each other, which will increase their shame.

Do you know that people in Hell have fire and worms?

In Hell, the unsaved people will have horrible company:

The unsaved will have the devil, the demons, the false prophet, and the Antichrist as companions (Matthew 25:41; Revelation 20:10). In Hell will be all those who have done lawlessness, all those who offend (Matthew 13:41-42); there will also be the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars (Revelation 21:8).

But God's love tells you now that He does not want you to go to Hell; that is why He sent His Son, Jesus Christ to die for your sins and give you eternal life in abundance, eternal life in the Kingdom of Heaven. Whoever does not repent of his sins, does not receive Christ in his heart, and does not believe in Him and obey Him, will not be able to enter the Kingdom of God and, consequently, will go to Hell for eternity.



The Bible says in 1 Corinthians 6:9-10: «Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.» If you have committed one of these sins or any other, and you repent with all your heart, God forgives you because the Bible says: «And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.» (1 Co 6:11).

Today you can be saved if there is true repentance in your heart, and you can make this prayer with faith:

“My God, forgive all my sins. Today, I recognize that I have lived separated from You; and do the evil before Your sight, but today I ask You forgiveness, wash me, help me. Lord Jesus, I receive You as my only Lord and Savior, and I ask You to make me a child of God; I want to escape from all the judgment that is to come to this Earth; I don't want to go to the Hell for the eternity; I want You to take me to the Kingdom of heaven to live by Your side for all eternity, Amen”.

KNOW GOD'S GREAT LOVE



God says in the Bible in John 3:16: «For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.» God speaks here about eternity. The Bible says that He has put eternity in men: «He has made everything beautiful in its time. Also He has put eternity in their hearts, except that no one can find out the work that God does from beginning to end.» (Ecclesiastes 3:11). When a human being dies, his soul goes to Heaven to

In John 3:16, God tells us that whoever believes in His Son, Jesus Christ does not perish but has eternal life, and that's the love of God. What does God mean when He talks about perishing? When the Bible speaks about perishing, it refers to condemnation in Hell. The Lord Jesus Christ told the religious of His time that rejected Him: «Serpents, brood of vipers! How can you escape the condemnation of hell?» (Matthew 23:33). The LOVE OF GOD manifests in that whoever repents of his sins, receives Christ in his heart, and believes in Him, will not go to Hell, will not perish in Hell, and will not be condemned in Hell, which is a place of torment for eternity. Today we want you to know what the Hell is like; that way, you will see the great LOVE OF GOD that invites you to repent and receive Christ into your heart so that you do not go to that horrible place.

HELL IS REAL Many people say that Hell doesn't exist, that it's a tale, a lie, an invention. But the Bible teaches that Hell is real place where all the unsaved people will go, those who rejected the gospel of Jesus Christ, didn't repent of their sins, and didn't receive Christ as their only Lord and Savior. Let's take a look what the Hell is like:



The story of the rich man and Lazarus (Luke 16) talks about Hell and those who go to this place; the characteristics are: **(1)** It is a place of torment: «And being in torments in Hades, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom» (Luke 16:23). **(2)** The people there will be fully conscious: people will see and talk. «...and **saw** Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom... "Then he **cried** and **said**...» (Luke 16: 23-24). **(3)** The people there will have emotions, and feelings. They will feel extreme pain and torment: «'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for **I am tormented** in this flame.'» (Luke 16:24), «but now he is comforted and **you are tormented.**» (Luke 16:25).

(4) It's a place of fire, where flames cause torments, indescribable pain: «for **I am tormented** in this flame.'» (Luke 16:24). **(5)** There's no option to leave Hell: «And besides all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed, so that those who want to pass from here to you cannot, nor can those from there pass to us.'» (Luke 16:26). **(6)** There's no option to return to life; there isn't a second chance nor reincarnation: «'I beg you therefore, father, that you would send him to my father's house, for I have five brothers, that he may testify to them, lest they also come to this place of torment.'» (Luke 16:27-28). **(7)** The reason why one goes to Hades-Hell is because of the rejection of God's Word, His plan of salvation, which is only in Christ Jesus: «Abraham said to him, 'They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.' And he said, 'No, father Abraham; but if one goes to them from the dead, they will repent.'» (Luke 16: 29-30). The rich man planned that the sign would convince his family and not the Word of God, but the Word of God is the one that converts the soul (Psalm 19:7) and pierce even to the division of man's soul and spirit (Hebrews 4:12). **(8)** Repentance only comes by God's Word, not by signs: «But he said to him, 'If they do not hear Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded though one rise from the dead.' "» (Luke 16:31).



Also, the Bible says that it's appointed for all men to die and rise again, and those who died without Christ will be judged on the Great White Throne to go to Hell, the Lake of Fire. Revelation 20:11-13 says: «Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is *the Book of Life*. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books. The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works.»

Because they have not repented of their sins and rejected Jesus Christ, their names won't be written in the book of life: «And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.» (Revelation 20:15). The Lake of Fire is the eternal Hell; what is it like?

Hell is a place of darkness: In the Bible, it is called: "the outer darkness" (Matthew 8:12), "the blackness of darkness" reserved for those whose eyes are full of adultery, who despise authority, whose hearts are trained in covetous practices (2 Peter 2: 10, 14, 17); as "the blackness of darkness forever" (Jude 1:13); and this darkness in Hell will be worse than any physical, moral, mental, or spiritual darkness experienced here on Earth.



Hell is a place with fire that will torment eternally: When the Lord Jesus talked about Hell, He described it as unquenchable fire (Matthew 3:12), Hell fire (Matthew 5:22), the burning fiery furnace where will wailing and gnashing of teeth (Matthew 13:40-42).

Hell is a place where the worm that does not die will be: These worms are real beings that will torment the people who are cast into Hell, but this worm also refers to the torment of the guilty of conscience. It is the guilt of sins that will be permanently in the minds of the unsaved people in Hell that will anguish them; all the sins will cause endless remorse, but they will also remember in Hell all the times that the gospel of Jesus Christ was preached to them for salvation and they never received, they permanently rejected the truth, did not want to repent and continued their life of sin. They will also suffer the greater shame of knowing that they have not fulfilled the only purpose for which they were created, which was to give glory to their Creator by obeying His will.
